**Saiva**  
A film by Tuva Synnevag

The indigenous people of Scandinavia are the Samies. This film is a personal interpretation of a way of thinking, that was widespread amongst the Samies in Sapmi, - but also throughout Siberian tribes, - that when you die, you come to a place where everything is opposite from this world.

West German terrorist Norbert Kröcher was arrested on March 31, 1977. He was leading a group planning to kidnap politician Anna-Greta Leijon. A number of suspects were arrested in the days following. One of them was Kröcher's ex-girlfriend, "A". This is her story.

Anders and Harri are best friends. They share an interest in music. Anders is also very fond of trains. This is a film about friendship, fears and trains...and suddenly there is music in the air.

An unsettling but important film about when a system becomes more important than a person's life.

Little Jonna and her friend Emilie play at being soldiers, but Jonna's mother doesn't approve of the course their game takes. The film portrays a young girl's ability to communicate through the use of body language and signals rather than words, against the mother's need for wording and explanation.

Sara prepares a surprise for her wife Katarina's birthday with the help of their daughter Johanna and their friend Fredrik. But on this early summer day, Katarina has something to tell her.
